




Dear Northside Family,

**How does it work?**

I may never get used to how we can Google or YouTube questions about how certain things work and how to control them and get that information almost immediately. How to reprogram my garage door openers seems the most frequently used and helpful. (you can insert your own eye-roll face here). We Americans love to know how things work so we can control them. But when it comes to the Holy Spirit, scripture spends very little time on HOW he works and a lot of time on WHAT he does for Christians.

Romans chapter 8 is an area of scripture where Paul lists several things the Spirit does for Christians. First of all, he has a "law" of life that sets us free from the law of sin and death (v2). We can set our minds on what the Spirit desires (v5). We can be controlled by the Spirit (v9). He can live in us and, if he lives in us, God will raise us from the dead through the Spirit (v11). By the Spirit we can put to death the misdeeds of the body (v13). We can be led by the Spirit (v14). He testifies with our spirits that we are God's children and heirs (v16-17). He helps us in our weakness of not knowing what to pray for and intercedes for us as we pray and wait for the resurrection (v23 and v26).

That is a lot of information about the Holy Spirit in just one half chapter of Romans! As you read the Bible, pay more attention to that 6 letter word that begins with a capital S. Look at all the things scripture says he has done, is doing, and will do. I think you will agree, when it comes to the Spirit, the WHAT is far more important than the HOW.

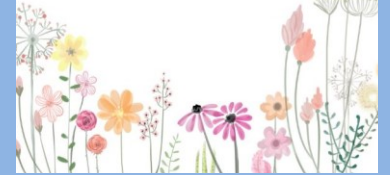
