LOST IN
Translation

The scholars that have translated the Greek New Testament into English have had a very difficult job. The Greek guide for the tour of Macedonia we had last year shook his head in disappointment several times a day while speaking to us. Many times, he said, there just isn't a good English word that fully communicates the deeper, richer Greek idea. He gave us the example of the Greek word "philotimo".

Philotimo means always doing what is right in any situation. It's a personal sacrifice for the good of others or the group. It's risking financial or personal injury/death to do the right thing. It is a duty, but it's also a personal choice. What single English word would you choose that would convey this Greek word's full meaning? Philotimo's meaning carries the ideas of courage, deep sacrificial love, commitment to the highest standard of decision making and action, and personal risk! How do you pick just one word?

In 2 Corinthians 5:9 the translators chose the word "goal". "So we make it our goal to please Him, whether we are at home in the body or away from it". In 1 Thessalonians 4:11 the translators chose the word "ambition". "Make it your ambition to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business, and to work with your hands, just as we told you, so that your daily life may win the respect of outsiders, and so that you will not be dependent on anybody". Also "ambition" was chosen in Romans 15:20 where Paul says "It has always been my ambition to preach the gospel where Christ was not known, so that I would not be building on someone else's foundation".

The English single words goal and ambition really fall short don't they? Don't let philotimo be lost in translation, let us all decide to make a deeper, courageous, risky, sacrificial commitment to please the Lord, whether we are at home in the body or away from it.
