NO LOOKING DOWN NECESSARY


It is hard to imagine our world without the cellphones we are now all so used to. It is as though the entire world is experiencing the rest of the world through handheld screens. People walk around with their noses glued to their cellphones; I've chuckled at video clips of people so focused on their phone that they trip into fountains or run into things. And even in restaurants, it seems as though people not actually round the table may have a better claim on our attention than those physically present! And yet, the smartphone, as we now know it, only appeared in 2007 (Apple)/2008 (Android), a mere 16 years ago. The telephone per se was invented in 1876 by AG Bell, but it would be another while before the trend fully caught on. For those my age, talking on the (landline) phone meant being tied to a long cord. Private calls required unraveling a 25 foot cord from the wall phone and taking the receiver into a private room.

But now we can all talk directly (and through video calls, also see directly) anyone anywhere in the world who has one of these small staples of modern life. They have come a long way in a short time : one of my first cell phones (late 1990s) was a heavy bag phone with an antenna magnetically placed on the roof of the car!

Is there a lesson to be learned for us Christians here? I believe there is : we regularly speak to God through prayer. No intermediary device is necessary; wherever we are, we can refer ourselves to God, share with him, ask for counsel and help, and above all submit ourselves to his will, worshiping him in the way we reminded ourselves about, this last Sunday in the sermon (Revelation 5:11-13). What's more, in communicating directly with God, we do not need to glue our faces to a screen - we can look up, and around ourselves, admiring God's work, or bow our heads and offer a prayer to him.

In the early years of the telephone, social critics warned of the dangers of a device that would "fray" the "old forms of civility." But the yearning for contact and communication would not be denied. By the 1920s, one third of all US households contained phones. May we cultivate a yearning for contact and communication with God that will not be denied: no looking down necessary. Stephen Powers
