Cleaning House

The cleansing of the temple by Jesus may be one of the most misunderstood moments in the gospêls. It is frequently used by people as justification for flying into a rage and making a scene. The reasoning is that if even Jesus could lose his temper and resort to violence, then it is no wonder that we, mere mortals, often do so as well. But the problem with this line of thinking is that Jesus **didn't** lose control. On the contrary he is asserting it, exercising his authority like a judge banging the gavel, pronouncing judgement, and calling the courtroom to order. Like many of the Old Testament prophets (Jeremiah, Hosea, Ezekiel....), Jesus is drawing a line, making a point, showing the limits of acceptable behavior and underlining that turning God's house of prayer into a market was intolerable and disrespectful to God. Bargaining, disorder and general chaos had taken the place of humility, prayer and adoration.

We would do well to consider that, by cleansing the temple, Jesus was doing more than ridding the temple courts of noise and clutter. Rather, Jesus was making a prophetic gesture – like Jeremiah smashing a flask in front of the elders of Judah, or Ezekiel enacting a symbolic siege by lying on his side for a number of days. By declaring "destroy this temple and I will rebuild it in three days," Jesus was forever tying the cleansing of the temple to the gospel (his death, burial and resurrection). Jesus' purpose in coming to the earth was far more than cleansing God's house of corruption. It was cleansing men's hearts from corruption. Viewed in this light we see that Jesus' actions on this day were not a boiling over of anger or violence, but a prophetic gesture with profound meaning. "I am the Messiah. I have come to clean house: the house of God, and the hearts of men".
