THE POOR

The Proverbs are filled with wisdom to guide the people of God on their treatment of the poor. *"He who oppresses the poor shows contempt for their Maker, but whoever is kind to the needy honors God"* Proverbs 14:31

The Poor
 It can be problematic to decide what "poor" actually means. Are the poor simply people who have less money than I do? Is there a poverty line below which people are considered poor? In rough terms, it appears that the 'average' American household lives on around \$185 a day. However, the world bank estimates that about 9% of the world's population (i.e. around 720 million people, more than twice the total population of the USA) live on less than \$2 per person per day. This is a huge difference. Additionally, statistics reveal that in 2019 70% of the world population lived in areas where the official poverty line is too low - meaning that there are vast numbers of people without enough money and with few possessions, many of whom quite clearly urgently need help to survive. The problem is so gigantic and so serious, it may seem that it is impossible to help in any meaningful way. Perhaps we could inspire ourselves with the text of the sermon on Sunday September 17th : "She (Mary of Bethany) did what she could". Let us all do what we can in our immediate neighborhood, and (in Northside's case) for the mission in Honduras, where 60% of the population live in poverty, with 32% of the total living in extreme poverty, especially in rural areas. This implies living on less than \$1.90 per person per day. Food for thought.....

Contempt vs. Honor
Contempt and **Honor** are strong words. The Proverbist utilizes these strong words to reveal an important and central Bible truth: the way we treat others is inextricably linked to our relationship with God. Jesus highlighted this same truth in his Judgement Day description in Matthew 25. "The King will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did for the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me'" (*Matthew 25:40*). When the person of God takes advantage of the poor, he shows contempt for God who is a "father to the fatherless, a defender of widows" (*Psalms 68:5*). Conversely, when the person of God is kind to the poor, he shows honor to God. We don't have to look outside our own city limits to find those who are poor. May we cultivate sensitive and wise hearts that love the poor, have compassion for the poor and help the poor. In doing so we will show love and honor to God: the Maker of all.
