**YOUR FIRST LOVE**

*"You have forsaken your first love. Remember the height from which you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first." (Revelation 2:4b-5b)*

**From the mouth of Jesus.**  
 When casting our eyes on the first few chapters of Revelation we note that these words are spoken by Jesus himself – they are in red letters in my Bible. These words of Jesus are addressed to the seven churches of Asia. We are familiar with the apostle Paul writing letters to the Christian churches, but these words from Revelation are unique in that they come from the mouth of Jesus. Direct words spoken directly to these churches.

**The churches' spiritual health.**  
 Interestingly, the words spoken by Jesus are specific to the spiritual concerns of each church. There is no mention of the day-to-day schedules or organizational structures and buildings. Rather, Jesus speaks to the heart of their faith – the spiritual vitality and health of each congregation. In essence, he gives them a spiritual pep talk – "Continue to do the things that have brought faithfulness, put aside those things that keep you spiritually weak."

**Jesus redirects the Ephesus church.**  
 Jesus is pointing out a process that often happens in human organizations, and in this case the Church at Ephesus. Paul lit their flame of faith in the spring of 52AD on his second missionary journey, returning during his third journey and staying for 3½ years. These were the years of Priscilla, Aquila, and of Apollos. Later, Timothy was sent to be the leader of the church there, and then it was the turn of the Revelation writer himself, John, before he was exiled to the island of Patmos (which is where he had the vision of Jesus addressing the 7 churches). The process is easy to understand : the enthusiasm and eagerness with which the church began its faith journey gave way to distractions, discouragement and the loss of spark that often follows. The result was that the initial enthusiasm waned (the 'first love - the height from which the church fell' in our text of today). The call to *repent and do the things [they] did at first* is a call we all need to hear and heed. We must not forsake the drive and sense of adventure of the start of our Christian journey! We must not allow the message to become stale; we must not slip into lazy ways that are easier and less demanding to follow. We must rekindle our faith flame anew each day, each week, each month, each year by reading and re-reading the word of God in the Bible and refresh ourselves in humble prayer each morning, each midday and each evening, saying, with the angels : *"Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come! You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power."* (Revelation 4:8, 11).
