HAS MADE HIM *No one has ever seen God, but God the One and Only, who is at the Father's side, has made him known.*
Known (John 1:18)

When Abraham came back from defeating the King of Elam (**Genesis 14:9**), he met the priest-king Melchizedek who blessed Abraham in the name of "the God most high, maker of heaven and earth" (**Genesis 14:18**). Have you ever stood on a clear winter's night and looked up at the stars, awed by the majesty of God's universe above you? Have you seen the images sent back by the recently launched James Webb telescope? Among them there is a picture of a star ('Earendel') in the faintest discernible galaxy, that is 13.3 billion light years from our tiny Blue Planet. God is so infinite, so unsearchable, so unknowable, so awe-inspiring ("The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom". **Isaiah 40:28**)... that we, so finite, so limited, so rooted in time and space can never ever hope to know even the minutest fraction of the mind of God. And yet, our faith, given by the same all-knowing God, aspires to this challenge, and strives ever upward to discern just exactly the unknowable presence of our creator. And so God gave us Jesus, the perfect man, who allows us the longed-for glimpse of eternity and completeness

The "unknowable" (**Isaiah 40:28**) Most High God made himself known to mankind through the person of Jesus of Nazareth. The tangible, seeable, touchable and relatable Jesus forever changed God's relationship with man. No longer is God unsearchable, rather, He is observable : his life, his compassion, his sorrow, his words. The Hebrews writer states that "*The son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being*" (**Hebrews 1:3**). In our text under consideration, John declares that no one has ever seen God. In fact, God told Moses that no human could see God and live (**Exodus 33:20**). But, humans CAN see Jesus: as flesh and blood - he hurt, he cried, he mourned, he smiled, he breathed, he slept, he died. He is relatable, tangible, understandable. By knowing Jesus, we know God. How precious is the Son of God. The more we know the Son, the more we know the Father. "The Son has made known the Father" (**John 1:18**).
