NOAH, DANIEL AND JOB "Even if these three men - Noah, Daniel and Job - were in it (unrighteous Israel), they could save only themselves by their righteousness, declares the Sovereign LORD." Ezekiel 14:14

If God were to choose ideal Old Testament faithful men for us to emulate, who would he pick? Certainly these three (Noah, Daniel and Job) would make the list. In our verse under consideration, God personally names these three men as righteous.

Noah : (Genesis 6:9 - *Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked with God.*) Early in the Biblical record, we are impressed with Noah. Not only did he stand alone as blameless in a wicked society, but he withstood the enormity of certain ridicule in constructing a massive boat, with only his family to support him. Peter names Noah as a preacher of righteousness (2 Peter 2:5), whose "sermons" in the end were only heeded by his own family. Noah teaches us that righteousness often stands alone in an unrighteous world. Noah certainly made God's list because of his obedient faith: trusting, enduring, persevering.

Daniel : (Daniel 6:4 - *[The administrators] could find no corruption in him, because he was trustworthy and neither corrupt nor negligent.*) Daniel's story inspires individuals seeking to emulate his God-given qualities : his faith, wisdom, courage, and moral integrity. Additionally, God had granted Daniel the power to interpret dreams and to warn the leaders of the consequences of not respecting the One God. Despite all the honors which were heaped on Daniel (as a reward for interpreting dreams), he remained humble. His moral integrity was second to none : even in the face of certain death, he reminds us of the importance of remaining steadfastly committed to God.

Job : (James 5:11 - *As you know, we consider blessed those who have persevered. You have heard of Job's perseverance and have seen what the Lord finally brought about.*) Job's god-fearing character serves as a powerful example of steadfast faith, patience, and spiritual resilience in the face of great trials. His story especially resonates with those seeking to understand what seems unexplainable, all the while receiving bad and contradictory advice from friends. We may not understand God's will, but Job shows us that it is possible to trust completely under the hardest of all imaginable circumstances.
