

#### Spirit of Generosity

"For if the willingness is there, the gift is acceptable according to what one has, not according to what he does not have" (2 Corinthians 8:12).

### Generosity and the Christian

Of all people, Christian people should be the most generous. After all, Christians have been given much, forgiven much and should be aware of their role as stewards of God's blessings. In our text, Paul praises the Corinthians for their generosity and urges them to follow Christ's example of selfless giving. As Christians, we want to live like Christ as much as we are able to. Being human we will fail, but our aim is to approach everything with enthusiasm and see it through to completeness - just like Jesus himself did. I guess your grandparents were likely similar to mine: "If it's worth doing, then it's worth doing well." This was the motto my grandfather lived by; and Christ would surely have approved. Remember the widow from our lesson a few weeks ago? She gave two small coins at the temple, all she had to live on, and she gave freely without worrying. She gave more than anyone else - Jesus says: "She gave out of her poverty", and she gave everything she had. What remarkable generosity! In the gospels, Jesus suggests that it is often easier for the poor to give; money has less power over them, and they probably have a looser relationship with it than the affluent who tend to put their hopes in, and hold too tightly to, their riches. We remember the warnings of Jesus about rich men, camels and the eye of a needle. There is a great lesson here to be learnt about attachment to money, giving freely with a generous heart and giving with willingness.

## **Generosity and Willingness**

In order for generosity to have eternal value it must be offered in the spirit of willingness. We all know what it is like to feel panhandled or coerced into parting with our money for one cause or another. We may find ourselves, at these times, digging begrudgingly through our wallets to find enough money to satisfy the moment and relieve the pressure put upon us. Christian

Indeed, Christian generosity loses its beauty when it is driven by guilt, pressure, or to attract the praise of others. Rather, Paul clarifies in our text that acceptable generosity is always generosity in the spirit of willingness. Paul called this kind of generosity the "grace of giving", and it is to be "excelled" in (2 Corinthians 8:7).

May we all strive to excel in the generosity that characterizes Christian people, and may we always give with a caring and willing spirit. -**Stephen Powers**


