

HONESTY

"Honest scales and balances belong to the LORD"

(Proverbs 16:11)

"My word is my bond." My dad once told me that when he was young, a handshake was as good as any promissory note or signed contract. Honesty was the norm. Security cameras were unneeded because most people lived by the standard of honesty. Proverbs speaks often about honesty. An honest scales (accurate, fair, honorable, correct) belongs to God. Proverbs 16 speaks clearly to God's standard of honesty: it belongs to the Lord. Scales that are correct, are honorable. Let's expound upon this more deeply.

It really does seem to be a noticeable trend in the times we live in that the "truth" no longer is the rock that it used to be some years ago. I guess most of us grew up with strict rules, based on Biblical standards, which guided the morality of our grandparents. People used to be able to leave their homes unlocked, leave for a two-week vacation and come back knowing the house (and its contents) would be safe and sound - people respected property. Now, if a door is left unlocked, it is an open invitation for anyone to help themselves. Squatters may move in, thieves may take valuables. In yesteryear, rare was the need for locking one's car - car keys dangled from the ignition, with no thought of theft. In our modern age, those in authority are often held in suspicion for their inability to keep their word: we've all heard of those who "misspeak" when they actually have blatantly told a lie. It seems that honesty and respect are now on a sliding scale that may be tuned to suit circumstances.

Proverbs 28:18 states: Whoever walks in honesty will be safe, but whoever travels the crooked path will suddenly fall. Godfearing Christians should strive for honesty, giving honest work and effort, putting aside mediocrity and half truths—never stealing time from employers or giving dishonest effort. May we always offer the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth, so help us God. May we live with honesty and integrity so that one day we may hear "Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things ...: enter thou into the joy of thy lord." (Matthew 25:21).
