She Did What She Could
"She has done a beautiful thing to me. She did what she could." (Mark 14: 6, 8)
The occasion
Two days before The Passover, a woman came to the house of Simon the Leper in Bethany, where Jesus was 'reclining at the table', and anointed him with lavishly expensive oil. It is not known if the woman was Mary (of Bethany, as stated in John 12) or an unknown woman (Mark 14); but both stories agree that the gesture was extravagant. Nard (also known as spikenard) is an aromatic plant that has been prized for its fragrant oil for centuries. It grows in the Himalayan mountains of China, India and Nepal. The oil thus originated 3000 miles to the east, and 12 oz of it cost a year's wages. The woman's gift was unexpected, public and drew criticism.
The criticism
The woman was highly criticized by some of those present. "Just think how much good could be done for the poor with a year's wages!" But Jesus states that the woman has valued him and done a beautiful thing. One of the few times in the NT that Jesus talks about his own worth, welcoming the honor done to him.
She did what she could
The very fact that we are today considering this woman's gift is a fulfilment of Jesus' prophecy that "... wherever the gospel is preached throughout the world, what she has done will be told in memory of her (9)." She did what she could. She couldn't alter the political winds. She couldn't change the minds of the powerful. But, she could bow humbly at the feet of Jesus, lovingly and sacrificially anointing him. Jesus describes her actions as "beautiful".
May we follow this woman's example and do what we can: beautiful, selfless acts to honor and glorify Christ.


