

. even if these three men—Noah. Daniel, and Job—were in it. thev could save only themselves by their righteousness, declares the Sovereign Lord. (Ezekiel 14:14)

There is an intriguing mention of three Old Testament men found in the fourteenth chapter of Ezekiel: Noah, Daniel, and Job. The names come in the context about the judgments that would come upon a sinful land. In this passage, God is speaking to Ezekiel and explaining that even if these three righteous men were present in the land, their righteousness would only save themselves and not the entire nation.

NOAH: He was chosen by God to build an ark and save his family and pairs of creatures from the floodwaters. Noah is described as a righteous man who found favor in the eyes of God; he was blameless among his contemporaries, and during the building of the ark (which took some 120 years) he not only followed God's instructions to the letter, but also found time to warn the people around him about the impending judgement of God. Keywords: righteous - obedient - faithful.

DANIEL: He was a prophet and wise advisor who served in the courts of various Babylonian and Persian kings. Daniel's unwavering faith, wisdom, and righteousness are highlighted throughout the book. Keywords: wise - courageous - honest unshakably faithful.


JOB: He was a man known for his righteousness and integrity. Despite facing immense suffering and loss, Job remained faithful to God and maintained his righteousness, even in the midst of great adversity. Keywords: unwaveringly resilient faithful - incorruptible.

As Bible students we are blessed to have the scriptural accounts of these three faith-filled men, and are particularly impressed that God would mention them Himself, by name, as examples of faithfulness. This God-given validation alone should motivate all children of God to examine the lives of these three men, looking for clues to their faithfulness and emulating them.
