

LTC Kickoff- FAQ

What?

Leadership Training for Christ - an experience for youth in the churches of Christ around the region to develop their knowledge of the Bible and biblical principles, enhance their communication and leadership skills, and orient their energies and abilities to areas of Christian service.

Why?

Our Mission is to help 3rd -12th graders FIND their gifts, GROW deeper roots of faith and SERVE God and His Church now and in the future. We are teaching an active faith instead of a passive faith. Surveys show that only ½ of C of C youth remain faithful. Students who participate in programs like this have a retention rate of 92-100%.

When?

Mid-October until Easter. All team events will practice on Sunday nights. We will break to assemble with the rest of the congregation for singing and prayer, then dismiss to resume working during the sermon.

Where?

Sunday Nights: We will meet in the Educational Wing and/or Activity Building for practices. More details will be given to you about practice times for your child's specific event.

Convention: Is Friday and Saturday of Easter Weekend in Rogers, Arkansas

What is the Convention?

A chance to share what we have learned with others and be given a "grade" for feedback. It is a time to be encouraged by the many youth in this country who want to serve the Lord, and to make new friendships with other Christians.

What is my part as a parent?

Throughout the year, be involved with your child regarding LTC. Work with them on individual events at home, read their Bible chapters for Bible Quiz/Bowl, help them on their lines for Drama or Puppets, etc. You may also be asked to judge or monitor an event at the convention. The convention trip is intended to be a FAMILY trip we enjoy together. Only in extenuating circumstances will a student go to the convention without family.

We will have a kickoff event in a couple of weeks to give more event specific information and allow you and your children the chance to select the events that they will be doing.
